Bring A Radio To The Rink!

Sept. 27, 2006 - The Penn State Icers are pleased to announce that fans attending games at the Greenberg Ice Pavilion in the 2006-07 season will be able to listen to the webcasts of the games on a FM radio.

In addition to streaming the call of Icers games on FightOnState.com, the Icers broadcast team of Steve Penstone and John Mulhern will be feeding the signal through a low-power FM transmitter inside the Greenberg Ice Pavilion.

Fans can bring a portable FM radio, and tune to 87.5 to listen to the audio feed. Please respect your fellow fans by using headphones to listen to the webcasts.

Penstone is entering his fifth season as “the voice of the Icers”, and Mulhern returns for his fourth season as analyst.

Steve says, “I’m excited about the upcoming season. Coach Balboni will bring a new style of hockey to Penn State, and there are several new players that will thrill the fans with their speed and talent.” He adds, “I’m also excited about the new technology that will let Icers fans listen to John and I while they’re sitting in the arena. It also means we’ll have to be on our game, because we may get some instant feedback!”

Penstone expects that fans attending road games will be able to listen to the broadcast. “The system is portable, so barring any technical issues at other arenas, there should not be any reason why we can’t use it on road trips.”
