UNIVERSITY PARK, P.A. – The No. 3 ranked Penn State Icers (5-2, 5-1 ACHA) will renew their rivalry with No. 4 ranked Ohio University (10-1) this weekend for a highly anticipated pair of games.

The Icers host Ohio this Friday at 9 p.m. and then Saturday at 3:30 p.m. at the Greenberg Ice Pavilion.

The Icers enter the match-up winning two out of three games at the ACHA Division 1 Showcase. The Icers lost their opening game in the Showcase to No. 7 ranked Oklahoma but then rebounded with wins over Minot State and No. 14 Weber State.

The Bobcats are coming off a good performance at the Showcase in which they swept all three of their games including No. 19 West Chester. Led by top-scorers Clay LaBrosse and Paul Warriner, the Bobcats are seeking a fourth consecutive CSCHL regular season crown under the direction of head coach Dan Morris.

Admission to Icers' games is \$7.50 for adults and \$5 for students with IDs.
