UNIVERSITY PARK, P.A. – The No. 3 ranked Penn State Icers (7-2-0, 7-1-0, ACHA) will play host to No. 13 ranked West Virginia (9-5) this Friday at 9 p.m. then battle Drexel University (6-2) the following day at 3:30 p.m. Both games will be played at the Greenberg Ice Pavilion.

The Icers are hot coming off a weekend that saw them hand a pair of losses to No. 4 ranked Ohio University. Sophomore goaltender Nick Signet held the perennial powerhouse Bobcats to one goal in three games.

The West Virginia Mountaineers have lost three of their last five games including back-to-back losses this weekend to Scranton and Drexel. The Mountaineers are coached by Adam Blaine, 2005-2006 ECHA Coach of the Year, who led the team to their first winning season in 7 years last year.

The Drexel University Dragons are on a tear winning their previous six games. The Dragons defeated the aforementioned Mountaineers and Scranton this past weekend. They are coached by Gregg Marinari, who is entering his fourth season as head coach.
