Due to heavy pollution and lack of proper resources, these children experience health risks, which delays their potential progress. Without suitable transportation the students have irregular attendance, which hinders their development.

Indian National policy on education stresses the need for education for every child in the country.

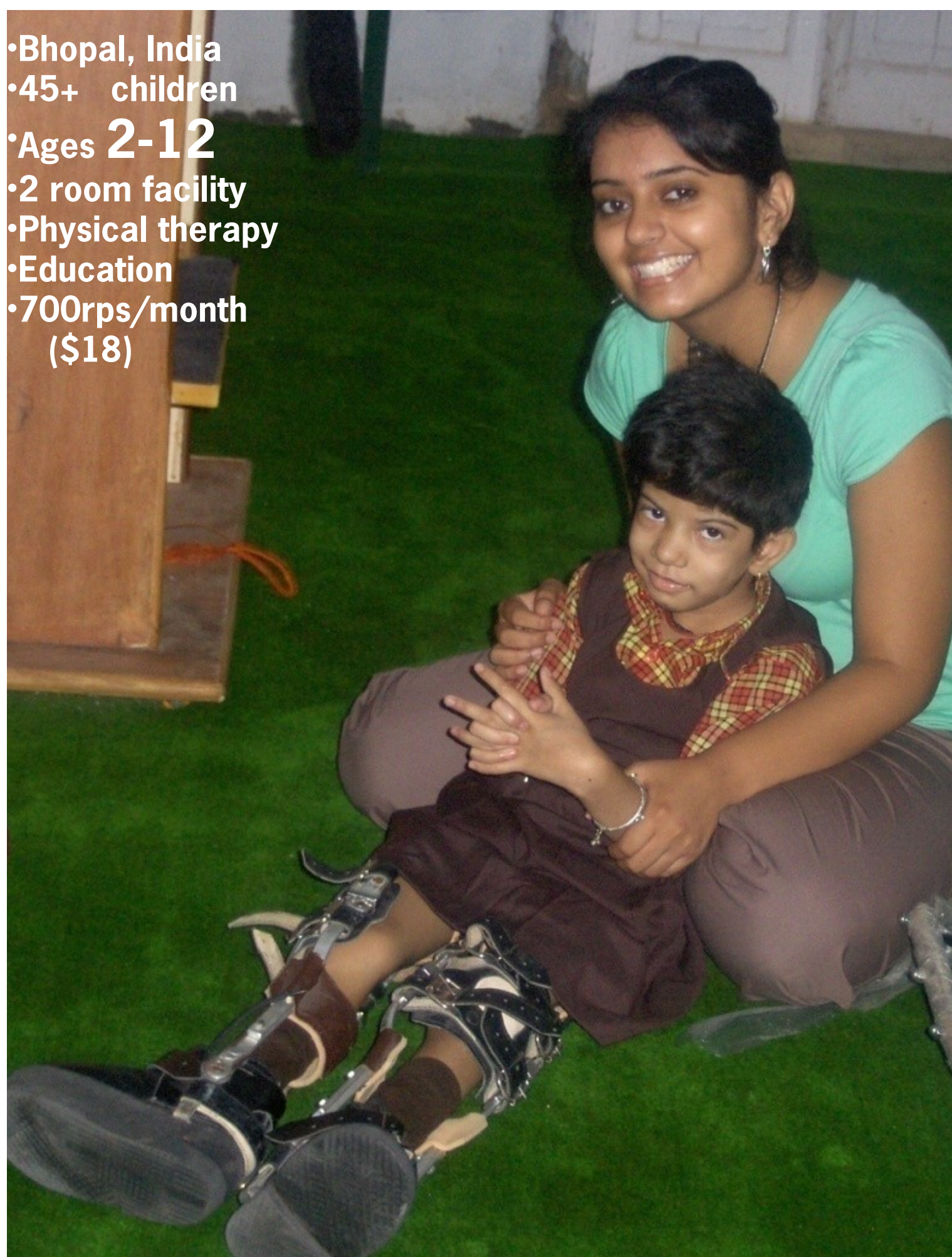
A child with disabilities is no exception.
